TITLE: Grounds Person

GENERAL SUMMARY

Perform skilled grounds work and general grounds maintenance.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Education and Experience

High school diploma or GED (General Education Degree).

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Knowledgeable about the use and maintenance of power and hand operated grounds equipment. Skills in maintaining a safe and orderly work environment.

Ability to operate light duty trucks, 40 horsepower wheel tractors pulling large turf mowers, riding lawn mowers and push mowers.

Ability to lift up to 50 pounds.

Possess valid Washington state driver's license.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform duties of a grounds person under direction of the Maintenance Supervisor and/or the Lead Grounds person.
- Perform general grounds maintenance tasks such as: lawn seeding, planting of shrubs and trees; weeding; edging; pruning and tree removal.
- Mow, fertilize, aerate, thatch top dress and irrigate lawns and fields.
- Prepare fields and courts for sports events such as: football, baseball, track, soccer and tennis.
- Remove trash from fields; clean the stadium; and haul garbage.
- Prepare stadium for special events.
- Assist other district employees in asphalt and concrete work; maintenance of playground equipment, fence repair, the installation and maintenance of irrigation and drainage systems.
- Performs minor repairs and periodic maintenance on grounds equipment including small gas engines, pick-up trucks, trailers, mowers, chain saws, and tractors.
- Applies herbicides for weed and brush control.
- Performs seasonal maintenance such as snow and ice removal, sanding and storm drain maintenance.
- Performs other duties as assigned, including work in other functional areas.
