TITLE: Network Technician

GENERAL SUMMMARY

This position will work closely with the Computer Repair and Telecommunications Technicians. Primary responsibility is to maintain the district computer network, including planning, installation of equipment, monitoring and troubleshooting network systems. Network Technician will provide support to district sites in upgrading an effective LAN/WAN.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Degree in computer science involving significant computer and program applications <u>or</u> completion of two years of vocational training in data network communications related field, <u>or</u> five years experience in networking field.
- Responsible professional work experience in networking multi-vendor platforms MS-DOS Windows and Macintosh AppleShare NT
- Experience with data communications components including various protocols and hardware.
- Experience in solving user problems with AppleTalk and TCP/IP environments over E Ethernet.
- Experience with Apple Macintosh PC systems . Familiarity with AppleShare and Windows NT desired.
- Experience in technical training desired.
- Experience in technical repairs.

- Provide classroom software training as directed by Technology Director.
- Perform other related tasks and responsibilities as assigned by Technology Director.
